improve the quality of life in the neighborhood in matters such as land use, environmental protection, public services and other matters of neighborhood concern.

I attended my first ANC meeting as our representative on Jan. 24. In my opinion, of most import was a presentation from Barbara McArthur from ANC on the Home Ordinance. This ordinance has far reaching implications for our member neighborhood associations. The council's mission align in many ways with the purposes set out in the COVNA bylaws. Our association states its purpose is to seek to neighborhood in that it drastically changes the Land Development Code. Changes include but they are not limited to density, setback requirements, and building height limitations. I am going to learn more about the Austin Tree Ordinance and if there are proposed changes to the Land Development Code that may diminish tree protection. Trees are one of our most unique aspect of our neighborhood.
